# At NPT Conference, Palestine Underscores No Justification for Israeli Exceptionalism, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, August 4, 2022.

There was no justification for Israeli exceptionalism in the Middle East region, Palestine underscored at the tenth Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of nuclear weapons (NPT) in New York.

# Palestinian Authority is Responsible for Torture and Ill-Treatment of Civilians, UN Report Says, MIDDLE EAST EYE, August 2, 2022.

In a series of recommendations, the United Nations Committee against Torture says PA should prosecute those responsible and punish them with appropriate penalties.

# Shtayyeh Calls on US Congress To Recognize State of Palestine to Achieve the Two-State Solution, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, August 2, 2022.

Prime Minister Mohammed Shtayyeh called on the US Congress to recognize the State of Palestine, which would contribute to the realization of the two-state solution, in light of the systematic destruction that this solution faces due to Israeli measures on the ground.

# UN Experts Slam Israel's 'Harassment' in West Bank, <u>ARAB NEWS</u>, August 2, 2022.

UN experts on Tuesday condemned Israel's "harassment" of human rights defenders and humanitarian workers in the occupied West Bank's Masafer Yatta villages, where Israel has a military zone.

Pressure Grows on UN Investigator to Resign After Jewish Lobby Remark, <a href="https://www.news.ncbi.nlm.news.news.ncbi.nlm.new

Pressure grew Monday on United Nations investigator Miloon Kothari to resign for reasons of antisemitism after he made reference to the Jewish Lobby in an interview, he gave to the Mondoweiss website last week. Kothari also questioned why Israel was a UN member.

### Saving Masafer Yatta: The Fight Against Expulsion, Mondoweiss, August 2, 2022.

In May 2022 the Israeli Supreme Court ruled to expel the Palestinians living in the South Hebron Hills of the occupied West Bank and hand their land over to the Israeli military. Meet the Palestinians fighting to stay in their homes and resist what rights groups are calling a war crime under international law.

## General-Secretary of PLO: Occupation's Government Continues Piracy and Theft of Palestinian Money, WAFA News Agency, July 31, 2022.

The Secretary-General of the Executive Committee of the PLO, Hussain al-Shaikh, said in a statement today that the [Israeli] occupation government continues with its money piracy over the Palestinians' funds and decides to deduct hundreds of millions of shekels to further embed the policy of financial blockade and steal our money.

He slammed the Israeli decision to deduct millions of Palestinian funds as a "step that adds to the daily escalation in our cities, villages, and camps and the legalization of our bloodshed."

## Rep. Carson Announces Bill to Require Investigation into Shireen Abu Akleh Killing, Mondoweiss, July 29, 2022.

The Secretary-General of the Executive Committee of the PLO, Hussain al-Shaikh, said in Two new legislative efforts to force the Biden administration to investigate the killing of Shireen Abu Akleh were announced this week.

# Palestinian Authority Arrest Campaign 'One of The Worst in Years', <u>ALJAZEERA</u>, July 29, 2022.

The Palestinian Authority (PA) is carrying out one of the largest political arrest campaigns in years against Palestinians in the Israeli-occupied West Bank, with at least 94 people arrested over the past two months.

UN official Navi Pillay is defending Miloon Kothari against accusations of antisemitism from pro-Israel groups, Israeli lawmakers, and U.S. officials following his interview with Mondoweiss.

Family members of slain Palestinian-American journalist Shireen Abu Akleh met with Secretary of State Antony Blinken to reiterate their calls for an independent investigation into her death.

### Palestinian Red Crescent Says 100 Injured in Israeli Crackdown on West Bank Protests, MIDDLE EAST MONITOR, August 3, 2022.

The Israeli occupation forces wounded 100 Palestinian protesters on Tuesday in a crackdown on protests against land grabs in Beit Dajan village, east of Nablus in the occupied West Bank, the Palestinian Red Crescent (PRC) has revealed.

# Some 100 Injured as Israeli Forces Crack Down on Anti-Land-Pillage Rallies Near Nablus, WAFA News Agency, August 2, 2022.

Israeli forces today cracked down on an anti-land-pillage rally in Beit Dajan village, east of the West Bank city of Nablus, injuring some 100 people, according to a WAFA correspondent.

# Israel Soldiers Were Carrying Out Orders in Kafr Qasem Amassacre of Palestinians, MIDDLE EAST MONITOR, August 1, 2022.

Newly declassified documents regarding the Kafr Qasem massacre have revealed that Israeli soldiers believed that they were obeying orders when they went on a killing spree which led to the massacre of 53 Palestinians.

## A 15-year-Old Child Hit in The Head by A Tear Gas Grenade Fired by Israeli Soldiers, WAFA News Agency, August 1, 2022.

A 15-year-old child was today hit in the head by a tear gas grenade fired by Israeli soldiers in the town of Kufr al-Deek, west of the northern West Bank city of Salfit, according to local sources.

The Israeli occupation authorities today ordered a halt on the construction of a Palestinianowned house in Faqqu'a village, northeast of Jenin city, according to the owner of the house.

Israeli military forces today broke into the village of Deir Abu Mesha'al to the west of Ramallah, according to an eyewitness.

### Scores of Israeli Settlers Break into Jerusalem's Al-Aqsa, <u>WAFA News</u> Agency, July 31, 2022.

Groups of Israeli settlers escorted by police broke today into the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in occupied Jerusalem and performed rituals in some of its courtyards, according to witnesses.

The United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) is pleased to announce the launch of its ambitious Information and Communication Technology for Education (ICT4E) Strategy to support its students, teachers, and education staff in becoming independent actors who can actively and critically engage with digital technology. The strategy is expected to serve over 540,000 Palestine refugee students and approximately 20,000

education staff in over 700 schools across Gaza, the West Bank (including East Jerusalem), Jordan, Syria and Lebanon.

# The PA is Gradually Being Cornered by Palestinian Society (Ramona Wadi), MIDDLE EAST MONITOR, August 2, 2022.

Palestinian Authority leader, Mahmoud Abbas, does not tolerate any political thought that is divergent from his brand of corruption. While the murder of Palestinian activist, Nizar Banat, last year by the PA's security services was marked with prominence, the PA has persisted in persecuting Palestinian activists, university students and journalists, under the pretext of safety for Palestinian civilians. Abbas has, perhaps, conveniently wiped out the memory of Palestinians being beaten for protesting against his rule and the security services' murder of Banat. The only safety Abbas wants concerns his rule. It could be said that possibly the PA is funded only to exist as a buffer zone between Palestinian civilians and Israel's colonial expansion and violence, for Israel's benefit, of course.

## Everyone is in on the Plunder of Palestinian Land (Orly Noy), <u>+972</u> MAGAZINE, August 2, 2022.

Israel's High Court has been facing torrents of criticism from much of the left and center of the Israeli political spectrum following its decision last week not to dismantle Mitzpe Kramim, a settler outpost in the occupied West Bank, claiming it was built "in good faith" on private Palestinian land.

### Vanguard in Humiliating Palestinians (Amira Hass), <u>HAARETZ</u>, August 2, 2022.

Sometime after three in the morning, the phone rings in the war room of the Palestinian security liaison and coordination office. The sleepy officer on duty hears the voice of his counterpart, a sleepy soldier at Israel's Civil Administration, announcing that the army is about to raid this or that Palestinian locality. What this means is that all Palestinian police must go into their offices at once. In the Civil Administration's internal slang, this task is known as "folding up SHOPIM," with SHOPIM standing for the Hebrew acronym for "Palestinian policemen." The phone warning and "folding up" are a routine both sides make sure to uphold, because "nobody wants one side to shoot at the other," as a former soldier in the unit told Haaretz.
