In the Spotlight

Foreign Ministry Condemns Israeli Escalation in The Occupied Territories, Calls for International Intervention, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, April 13, 2022.

The State of Palestine warns against Israel's escalating crimes against the Palestinian people, including collective punishment, targeting of civilians, and unlawful siege imposed on the city of Jenin, and calls on the international community to urgently intervene to protect the Palestinian people, today said the Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates in a statement.

Presidency Warns of The Danger of Israelis Slaughtering Sacrifices for The Jewish Holiday in Al-Agsa Mosque, WAFA News Agency, April 12, 2022.

The official spokesman for the Palestinian presidency, Nabil Abu Rudeineh, today said that threats by extremist Israeli to storm Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem's Old City to slaughter sacrifices for the Jewish Passover holiday under the protection of the occupation police, along with the threat to deploy more Israeli occupation forces in the Palestinian territories, will lead to a dangerous and uncontrollable escalation.

Six Palestinian NGO's Demand Action to Reverse Israel's 'Terror' Designation, Mondoweiss, April 12, 2022.

In a joint statement, the groups called on states to "take concrete action against the Israeli occupation authorities' continued harassment and criminalization of Palestinian human rights defenders and civil society organizations."

Rights Group: International Community Must Intervene to Stop Israeli Escalation of Violence Against Palestinians, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, April 12, 2022.

Violence by Israeli Occupying Forces (IOF) and Israeli colonial settlers continues to escalate against Palestinians across the occupied West Bank and Jerusalem in the fast month of Ramadan and the international community must intervene to put an end to this escalating violence, said the Palestinian human rights group, Al-Haq, in an action alert.

The Orthodox Patriarchate of Jerusalem affirmed "its strong and renewed commitment to our natural right to celebrate our holidays along with our congregation, our families and to



participate together in prayers at our churches in the Old City of Jerusalem, including the basic right of all our church members to access the Church of Holy Sepulchre and its vicinity during Easter festivities, including Holy Fire Saturday.

Premier Says Financial Support for Families of Martyrs and Prisoners Is Not Supporting 'Terrorism', WAFA News Agency, April 11, 2022.

Prime Minister Muhammad Shtayyeh rejected today an Israeli court's view of the Palestinian Authority as a supporter of "terrorism" because it pays the families of the martyrs and prisoners, stressing that his government's support for the families is not supporting "terrorism" rather it is "our duty towards the orphan sons of martyrs, and the prisoners and their families who need all our help."

Hamas Stops Islamic Jihad from Military Escalation with Israel in Gaza, AL-MONITOR, April 11, 2022.

Hamas and Islamic Jihad are coordinating policies and activities, stepping up attacks in the West Bank while trying to avoid direct confrontation in Gaza.

The two men were trying to reach the Tomb of Joseph, a Jewish holy site vandalized on Saturday as tensions in the West Bank rise in the wake of recent terror attacks in Israel.

Israeli soldiers shot dead a Palestinian woman in her forties after she approached them in a "suspicious manner" in the West Bank town of Husan, near Bethlehem, on Sunday.

Palestinian Detainee on Hunger Strike For 38 Days in Protest of Unfair Detention, WAFA News Agency, April 10, 2022.

Khalil Awawdeh, 40, a Palestinian in Israeli detention, has been on hunger strike for 38 days in protest of his detention without charge or trial, the Palestinian Authority's Detainees Affairs Commission has said.

Hamas: Israel Violating International Laws By Banning Gaza Patients From Travel For Treatment, <u>MIDDLE EAST MONITOR</u>, April 7, 2022.

A spokesman for the Islamic Resistance Movement (Hamas), Abdel Latif Al-Qanoua said Thursday, that the Israeli authorities continue to flagrantly violate international laws and humanitarian covenants by besieging the Gaza Strip, preventing the entry of medical equipment and devices into it, and preventing Palestinian patients from traveling abroad for treatment, as well as practicing medical negligence against Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails. In remarks to



Safa Agency on the World Health Day and the establishment of the World Health Organization (WHO), Al-Qanoua said the Israeli "racist behavior" against thousands of Palestinian patients "requires international organizations, especially the WHO, to redouble their efforts and play their role in saving the lives of Palestinian patients."

Palestine, Jordan Coordinating Diplomatic Efforts to Protect Al-Aqsa Mosque – Foreign Ministry, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, April 13, 2022.

Palestine and Jordan are coordinating their diplomatic efforts to protect Al-Aqsa Mosque, Islam's third holiest site located in Jerusalem's Old City, from attempts by Israel and Jewish fanatics to change it historic status as a Muslim-only worship site, today said the Palestinian Foreign Ministry in a statement.

UNRWA, Qatar Charity Support to UNRWA Emergency Food Assistance in Gaza, April 13, 2022



Qatar Charity contributed US\$ 1.5 million to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) in support of the Agency's food assistance in Gaza. Some 90,300 food-insecure persons living in the blockaded Gaza Strip will be able to meet their most basic food requirements for three months (one quarter) in this round of aid distribution.

<u>UNRWA</u>, The International Islamic Charity Organization Contributes Us\$ 500,000 To Provide Emergency Cash Assistance to Palestine Refugees in Gaza, April 13, 2022

The International Islamic Charity Organization IICO has contributed US\$ 500,000 to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) to provide emergency cash assistance to Palestine refugees in Gaza.

PLO Official Discusses UNRWA's Financial Crisis with UNRWA Commissioner-General, WAFA News Agency, April 12, 2022

Talks also covered efforts to setting a roadmap to permanently appoint 7.5 per cent of daily wage workers, the Jordan News Agency, Petra, reported. Kherfan lauded the agency's efforts to serve the Palestinian refugees, with Lorenzo expressing appreciation towards Jordan's unceasing endeavours in support of the agency.

What's the Story?: Aida Touma-Sliman on Israeli Apartheid, (by Aida Touma-Sliman), Mondoweiss, April 11, 2022.

Aida Touma-Sliman, a Palestinian member of Knesset and long-time women's rights and political activist, describes apartheid in Israel and the occupied territory and how it impacts Palestinian citizens of Israel in particular.

But no one will remember them. Who cares about Arabs?

Raad Hazem was born on Kaf Tet B'November, 1993 – November 29, the date of the 1947 United Nations votes to partition Mandatory Palestine. He was born into the hope of the Oslo Accords and grew up in the catastrophe of Operation Defensive Shield. He was nine when the Israeli tanks invaded his refugee camp, destroyed its center and killed 56 of its inhabitants. This boy saw in the streets bodies that could not be buried until the army left, tanks that crushed the homes and cars of residents whose lives were wretched and a bulldozer that flattened the camp and "turned it into Teddy Stadium" – the home field of the Beitar Jerusalem soccer team, whose most vocal supporters are the notoriously anti-Arab La Familia group – as the digger's driver bragged.

Israel Wave of Violence Skips Jerusalem, but Tensions Still Visible, (by Anshel Pfeffer), <u>HAARETZ</u>, April 10, 2022.

The suspension of evictions in Sheikh Jarrah and the restraint from both Israeli police and Palestinian youths have led to a surprising calm during a tense period throughout Israel – but all that could still change in an instant.



How to Prevent Further Escalation of Violence in Israel—Before It's Too Late, (by Daoud Kuttab), News Week, April 7, 2022.

News is breaking about another violent attack in Israel, the fifth in three weeks. This one, which took place in Tel Aviv, left two dead and 12 injured. It brings the total number of Israelis killed in recent weeks to 13. They join 18 Palestinians killed by Israeli forces in the first three months of 2022, whose deaths the United Nations has documented. How to combat this new wave of violence? The answer is perhaps simpler than one might expect: with good governance and with hope.
