US Lawmakers Demand White House Stop Israeli 'War Crime' in Hebron's Masafer Yatta, WAFA NEWS Agency, June 1, 2022.

15 US congress members Tuesday sent a letter to the US Secretary of State Antony Blinken and called on him to stop the Israeli government's expulsion of Palestinian people from the villages of Masafer Yatta in the occupied West Bank.

PM Shtayyeh: Int'l Community Must Take Concrete Measures, Impose Sanction on Israel, WAFA NEWS Agency, June 1, 2022.

Prime Minister Mohammed Shtayyeh said today the international community must move from condemning Israel to taking serious measures and sanctions against it.

UN Renames Palestine Media Programme After Slain Journalist Shireen Abu Akleh, WAFA NEWS Agency, June 1, 2022.

The United Nations has renamed the annual training programme for Palestinian broadcasters and journalists after al-Jazeera veteran slain journalist Shireen Abu Akleh who was killed by the Israeli forces in the occupied West Bank city of Jenin on 11 May.

Israeli Forces Kill Palestinian Journalist on Her First Day of Work, <u>The New Arab</u>, June 1, 2022.

Ghufran Warasneh is the second Palestinian journalist killed by Israeli forces in less than a month, after the killing of Aljazeera reporter Shireen Abu Akleh in the Jenin refugee camp on May 11.

Israel Returns Controversial Settlement Project in E1 Areas to the Agenda, MIDDLE EAST MONITOR, June 1, 2022.

The Israeli Defense Ministry is planning to advance a controversial settlement project in the E1 Area of the occupied West Bank after the Israeli government withdrew the plan in January amid international pressure, media outlets have reported.

The Islamic-Christian Committee in Support of Jerusalem and its Sanctuaries said yesterday that the "unprecedented" violations of Israeli settlers in Jerusalem pave the way for a religious war, Quds Press reported.

Hamas Leader Refuses to Give Guarantees Not to Escalate against Israel, The Palestine Chronicle, May 30, 2022.

The head of the political bureau of Gaza-based group Hamas refused on Monday to give guarantees not to escalate the situation with the Israeli army in the Palestinian Territories, The New Arab reported.

Extremist Israeli Settlers Hold Provocative Rally in Jerusalem, <u>THE</u> JORDAN TIMES, May 30, 2022.

Thousands of extremist settlers on Sunday started the annual "flag march" through Jerusalem that regularly stokes Palestinian anger, a year after tensions in the occupied city ignited Israeli aggression across Palestinian territories.

Al-Haq: The Shelling of The Khudair Warehouse in Gaza Is Tantamount to Chemical Warfare by Indirect Means, WAFA News Agency, May 28, 2022.

Al-Haq's newly established Forensic Architecture Investigation Unit (FAI Unit) examined the attack on the Khudair Pharmaceuticals and Agricultural Tools Company—the largest agrochemical warehouse in Gaza—and established that the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) employed highly flammable munitions in a targeted attack producing a toxic plume tantamount to the indirect deploying of chemical weapons.

49 Harvard Faculty Members Endorse Student Efforts to Oppose Israeli Apartheid, WAFA News Agency, May 28, 2022.

Forty-nine staff members at Harvard University have signed an open letter endorsing the Boycott, Divestments, and Sanctions movement and student efforts to oppose Israeli apartheid.

Jordan Stands in Solidarity with Palestine, Al-Mayadeen, May 29, 2022.

People in Amman, Jordan, stand in solidarity with the #Palestinian people by raising the Palestinian flag. Earlier, a parliamentary memorandum was submitted to demand the Jordanian government take action and end the Israeli occupation's hostilities against the Palestinians.

Jordan Condemns Allowing Israeli Flag March, Settlers' Storming of Al-Aqsa Mosque, WAFA News Agency, May 29, 2022.

Jordan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates condemned the storming of al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem by Israeli extremists and a Knesset member, warning of escalation due to permitting an Israeli flag march scheduled to begin today in Jerusalem, according to Jordan's Petra news agency.

Israel Examining Steps to Transfer Red Sea Islands to Saudi Arabia, HAARETZ, May 29, 2022.

President Mahmoud Abbas received Tuesday night a phone call from US Secretary of State Anthony Blinken.

China: Absence of Two-State Solution Reason for Conflicts Between Palestine, Israel, WAFA News Agency, May 30, 2022.

China said today that the underlying reason for the recurring conflicts between Israel and Palestine is the absence of the implementation of the two-state solution and the long denial of the Palestinian people's legitimate appeal for establishing an independent state.

As part of his constant engagement with the Palestine refugee community, the Commissioner-General of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) Mr. Philippe Lazzarini spent a day in Jenin refugee camp, in the northern occupied West Bank.

UNRWA Hosts High Level Meeting at Nahr Al Bard Camp, <u>UNRWA</u>, May 31, 2022.

The delegation expressed its support and commitment to Palestine refugees and UNRWA, despite the financial challenges they face especially due to other crisis and the war in Ukraine. They called on young people to continue with their education despite the difficulties because education provides hope for a better future. The visit ended with a meeting with representatives of the Palestinian community, who discussed with the delegation the need to complete the reconstruction of NBC as well as the difficult living conditions of Palestine refugees in Lebanon in general. They called on donor countries to increase their support to UNRWA and Palestine refugees as Lebanon continues to be affected by the ongoing economic crisis.
