On Saturday, March 12, 2022 – Nabil Abu Rudeineh, spokesman for President Mahmoud Abbas, condemned the decision of the Israeli occupation authorities to build 730 new housing units in the Israeli settlement of Pesgat Ze'ev in occupied East Jerusalem.

FM Al-Maliki Says Palestinians May Seek Action at UNSC Against Israeli Settlements, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, March 12, 2022.

On Saturday, March 12, 2022 – the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates Riyad Al-Maliki said that the Palestinian leadership is considering the possibility of going to the UN Security Council to urge it to assume its responsibilities regarding the Israeli settlement enterprise, especially Resolution 2334 on Israeli settlements.

Birzeit University Rejects Israeli Measures Against Academic Freedom, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, March 12, 2022.

On Saturday, March 12, 2022 – Birzeit University in Palestine said it rejects Israel's most recent attempt to constrict the fundamental right of Palestinians to education and to undermine the academic freedom and autonomy of Palestinian universities.

On Saturday, March 12, 2022 – The Palestinian human rights organization, Al-Haq, called on the prosecutor of the International Criminal Court (ICC) and the UN Commission of Inquiry to include Israeli attacks on cultural property in Palestine in their investigation of Israeli war crimes.

Church heads and officials in Jerusalem are fighting an Israeli plan to expand a national park on the Mount of Olives in east Jerusalem, where dozens of churches and Christian sites are located.

On Monday, March 14, 2022 - Adalah – The Legal Center for Arab Minority Rights in Israel yesterday filed a petition to the Israeli Supreme Court in its own name and on behalf of three Palestinian families against the Citizenship and Entry into Israel Law (Temporary Order) – 2022 adopted by the Israeli Knesset on 10 March 2022.

The Department of Palestinian Affairs on Sunday held a coordination meeting for representatives of Arab countries hosting Palestinian refugees with the participation of delegations from Lebanon, Syria, Palestine, Egypt and the Arab League.

OIC Condemns Israel's Approval to Build 730 New Settlement Units in Occupied Jerusalem, *WAFA News Agency*, March 13, 2022.

On Sunday, March 13, 2022 - The Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) condemned the Israeli occupation authorities' approval of new plans to build 730 new housing units in the Pisgat Zeev settlement, built illegally on land belonging to Palestinian residents in the town of Beit Hanina, north of occupied Jerusalem.

Lapid Meets King Abdullah, Bids To Lower Tensions With Palestinians As Holidays Near, <u>THE TIMES OF ISRAEL</u>, (by Jacob Magid), March 10, 2022.

Residents of the village of Battir say the settlement has prevented them from accessing their lands.

Hebron Hills, declared part of a firing zone for Israeli military purposes, the European Union Representative Sven Kühn von Burgsdorff warned that expulsions would be a breach of Israel's obligation as the occupying power.

On Saturday, March 12, 2022 - In a meeting with the European Union's Commissioner for Neighborhood Policy and Enlargement, Oliver Varhelyi, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates Riyad Malki urged the EU to overcome technical and other obstacles and resume financial support for the Palestinian Authority in light of the decline in international aid during the past years.

France's interior minister announced on Wednesday the dissolution of two major pro-Palestinian organizations, 'Comité Action Palestine' and 'Palestine Vaincra', accusing them of inciting hatred and violence.

Palestinian Refugees Are More Politically Isolated Than Ever, <u>MIDDLE</u> <u>EAST MONITOR</u>, March 15, 2022.

"The almost unanimous political support expressed by the UN General Assembly to the Agency is not translated into matching financial resources," UNRWA's Commissioner-General, Philippe Lazzarini stated during the 157th session of the Council of the Arab League, which was held in Cairo, Egypt.

President Abdel Fattah Al-Sisi affirmed Egypt's absolute support for the UNRWA to continue to play its role in providing services to Palestinian refugees, as it is the only mechanism that carries out this important humanitarian responsibility, especially in the fields of education and health.
