Palestine Holds Grand State Funeral for Iconic Slain Palestinian Journalist, WAFA News Agency, May 12, 2022.

Palestine Thursday morning held a grand state funeral for an iconic Palestinian journalist killed yesterday by Israeli military gunfire in the West Bank refugee camp of Jenin.

Al Jazeera's Shireen Abu Akleh killed in Israeli Raid: Live News, **ALJAZEERA**, May 11, 2022.

Shireen Abu Akleh, 51, was covering an Israeli army raid on the Jenin refugee camp when she was shot in the face.

King Meets Christian Leaders in the US, Warns Of Threats Against Christians in Jerusalem, THE JORDAN TIMES, May 10, 2022.

His Majesty King Abdullah on Monday warned against the continuous impediments facing Christians in the Palestinian territories, especially in Jerusalem, adding that continued pressures could threaten their presence in the region. At a meeting in New York with a number of Christian leaders in the United States, King Abdullah reaffirmed that Arab Christians are an integral part of the Middle East's past and present, and are vital to its future, stressing the need to work collectively to safeguard the Christian presence in the region, according to a Royal Court statement.

Biden to Meet Jordan's King Abdullah This Week Amid Jerusalem Tensions, <u>HAARETZ</u>, May 9, 2022.

U.S. President Joe Biden is set to meet with Jordan's King Abdullah II later this week, a source familiar with the meeting said on Monday, with Middle East regional issues expected to dominate the meeting. Jordan, the custodian of the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in Jerusalem, has been heavily involved in efforts to maintain calm in the city, which has seen repeated clashes between Palestinians and Israeli police over the past weeks, during the month of Ramadan.

Lapid: Israel Doesn't Need Permission from The US To Build in Settlements, THE JERUSALEM POST, May 9, 2022.



Israel doesn't need permission from the United States to build in West Bank settlements, Foreign Minister Yair Lapid told reporters in the Knesset. "Israel is a sovereign state and does not ask for permission to operate in its territory," Lapid said. He spoke amid the latest diplomatic row between Israel and the United States over the Higher Planning Council for Judea and Samaria's meeting on Thursday to advance and approve plans for 3,988 settler homes.

Palestine Refugee Agency Could 'Implode', UN Warns, <u>EURACTIV</u>, May 9, 2022.

The collapse of the international agency responsible for Palestinian refugees due to chronic underfunding by UN countries could lead to unpredictable consequences in an already unstable region, experts and officials warn. "The strong political support [for the agency] is not translated into matching resources," UNRWA commissioner-general Philippe Lazzarini told EURACTIV. Lazzarini fears the situation could deteriorate further and reach a "tipping point" where costs can no longer be covered, causing the "implosion of the organisation or push it into a situation where we will be unable to cover the needs." "The region in which we operate is a highly volatile one that cannot afford another crisis with unpredictable consequences," said Lazzarini.

Palestinians Need Stronger Ties to Area C, World Bank Said, THE JERUSALEM POST, May 9, 2022.

"Area C remains key to Palestinian economic development but access to this area remains severely limited," the World Bank said.

Foreign Ministry Condemns Israeli PM's Statements on Al-Aqsa Mosque, WAFA News Agency, May 8, 2022.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates condemned a tweet published by Israeli Prime Minister Naftali Bennett about the al-Aqsa Mosque, considering the statement as official Israeli recognition of targeting the Al-Aqsa Mosque and its courtyards as well as the Jordanian Islamic Endowment.

Jared Kushner To Invest Saudi Money in Israel for The First Time, <u>THE</u> NEW ARAB, May 8, 2022.

Jared Kushner's private investment firm, Affinity Partners, plans to invest capital from Saudi Arabia's sovereign wealth fund in Israeli businesses, according to the Wall Street Journal. This would mark the first time money from the kingdom's Public Investment Fund (PIF) will be invested in Israel.

Shtayyeh to Head to Brussels Today to Participate in Donors Committee Meeting, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, May 8, 2022.

Prime Minister Mohammed Shtayyeh, accompanied by an official delegation, will head today to the Belgian capital, Brussels, to participate in the Ad Hoc Liaison Committee (AHLC) scheduled to be held on Tuesday.



PA: Sovereignty Over Jerusalem, Holy Sites Belongs to 'The State of Palestine', THE JERUSALEM POST, May 8, 2022.

The Palestinian Authority on Sunday rejected Prime Minister Naftali Bennett's remarks that all decisions regarding the Haram a-Sharif (Temple Mount) and Jerusalem would be made by the government of Israel. "These statements are misleading and incorrect, as evidenced by the continuous incursions into the Aqsa Mosque and the restrictions on worshipers in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher during the recent holiday celebrations," PA presidential spokesman Nabil Abu Rudaineh said, according to a statement published by the Palestinian news agency Wafa.

'I'm Thrilled to Work with Israeli Government Because They Want to Do the Right Thing,' US Ambassador Says, Ahead of Settlement Announcement, Mondoweiss, May 7, 2022.

Days before Israel announced that it is going ahead with 4,000 new settlement units, the U.S. ambassador -- who was reportedly briefed on the plans -- says "I really respect this government... they really want to do the right thing," and he is "thrilled to work with them."

US State Department Says Israeli Settlement Plans Exacerbate Tensions and Undermine Trust Between the Parties, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, May 7, 2022.

The United States State Department criticized Israeli plans to expand the illegal settlements in the occupied Palestinian territories saying they exacerbate tensions and undermine trust between the parties.

US Denounces Israel's Push to Advance 3,988 West Bank Settler Homes, THE JERUSALEM POST, May 7, 2022.

The United States warned that Israel was harming prospects for a two-state solution by pursuing the advancement and approval of plans for 3,988 new West Bank settler homes. "Israel's program of expanding settlements deeply damages the prospect for a two-state solution," Deputy State Department spokesperson Jalina Porter told reporters on Friday.

While Welcoming the Us State Department's Position on Israeli Settlements, Foreign Ministry Says it is not Enough, <u>WAFA News</u> Agency, May 7, 2022.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates welcomed the position announced by the US State Department regarding the illegality of Israeli settlements in the occupied Palestinian territories, but considered it insufficient and does not rise to the level of the crimes of settlement construction.

Jordan has emphasized that it doesn't accept "participation or dictation from any party," including the Israeli government, regarding the appointment of security guards at the Aqsa Mosque compound (Temple Mount) in Jerusalem. The appointment of guards and employees at the Aqsa Mosque and Al-Haram Al-Sharif (the Noble Sanctuary) is within the mandate of Jordan and its Wakf Department in Jerusalem, the Jordanian Ministry of Wakf Islamic Affairs said in a statement on Monday. It said that the ministry is "the only body charged with implementing the Hashemite custodianship over Islamic and Christian holy sites and endowments and consolidating the historical and legal status quo."

Arab League Chief Rejects Israeli Attempts to Change Status Quo Of Jerusalem, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, May 9, 2022.

Arab League Secretary-General Ahmed Aboul-Gheit strongly rejected any Israeli statements or positions that would attempt to change the historical and legal status quo of Jerusalem.

Kuwait on Sunday warned of the consequences of Israel's plans to expand illegal Jewish settlements built in occupied Palestinian territories, Quds Press reported. OIC Condemns Israel's Plans to Build 4000 Settlement Units, Evacuate 12 Palestinian Villages in Yatta Area, WAFA News Agency, May 8, 2022.

Around 50,000 Palestine refugees who fled the conflict are currently in Lebanon and Jordan. They are among the most vulnerable refugee communities in the region. In Syria, most of them were displaced at least once. Like many Syrians, Palestine refugees were killed, detained and disappeared during the grueling conflict.
