Two Major US Media Outlets Confirm Palestinian Journalist Shireen Abu Akleh Was Killed by Israeli Gunfire, WAFA News Agency, May 25, 2022.

Two major American media outlets confirmed in two separate reports that Palestinian iconic journalist Shireen Abu Akleh was killed by Israeli army gunfire, and one even suggested that she was deliberately targeted.

Palestinian Human Rights Organizations Urge ICC Prosecutor to Open Cases from Israeli Attack on Gaza in 2021, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, May 24, 2022.

Palestinian human rights organizations - Al-Haq, Al-Mezan and the Palestinian Center for Human Rights (PCHR) – today filed a submission to the Office of the Prosecutor (OTP) of the International Criminal Court (ICC) providing a detailed description and analysis of the war crimes and crimes against humanity committed during the May 2021 Israeli military offensive against Palestinian civilians in the Gaza Strip and urged him to open cases from these attacks.

Israeli Occupation Forces: 'No Suspicion' Of Crime in Journalist Shooting, THE JORDAN TIMES, May 23, 2022.

Israel's occupation forces said Monday that if an Israeli soldier fired the bullet that killed Al Jazeera journalist Shireen Abu Akleh, it did not appear that the soldier was guilty of criminal misconduct.

A Visit by A European Parliamentary Delegation to Palestine Canceled After It Was Blocked by Israel, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, May 23, 2022.

A planned visit by a European Parliament delegation to Palestine was canceled after Israel denied the delegation entry.

Israeli forces today attacked a Palestinian-American female in Hebron's Old Town, in the southern occupied West Bank, according to WAFA correspondent.

Israeli Court's Ruling to Allow Jewish Prayers at Al-Aqsa Mosque, The Palestine Chronicle, May 23, 2022.

A ruling by the Israeli Magistrate's Court in Jerusalem – allowing certain Jewish prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque – has drawn strong condemnation at home and abroad and warning of serious consequences, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

Reports: US Diplomat to Meet Israeli Terrorist Leader at An Illegal West Bank Settlement, WAFA News Agency, May 22, 2022.

Israeli forces have intensified their military presence in Tel Rumeida area in central Hebron ahead of a visit for a US diplomat to the Israeli settlement of Ramat Yeshai, built illegally on Palestinian land in central Hebron, according to reports.

Five out of Six Gilboa Freedom Fighters Served an Additional Five-Year Sentence, WAFA News Agency, May 22, 2022.

Five out of six Palestinian prisoners who tunneled out of the high-security Israeli prison of Gilboa in September 2021 were sentenced today to an additional five years in prison, an Israeli court in Nazareth.

Presidency Condemns State Department's Removal of Israeli Group Kach from Terror Blacklist, WAFA News Agency, May 21, 2022.

The Palestinian presidency today strongly condemned the US State Department's decision to remove the Israeli terror movement Kach from the list of foreign terror organizations under the US Immigration and Nationality Act.

Greek Orthodox Patriarchate of Jerusalem: We Will Support All Efforts to Realize Justice for Shireen Abu Akleh, WAFA News Agency, May 21, 2022.

The Greek Orthodox Patriarchate of Jerusalem confirmed that it will support all efforts to realize justice for journalist Shireen Abu Akleh, who was shot and killed on May 11 in Jenin by Israeli

soldiers, said Archbishop Aristarchos of Constantina, General Secretary of the Patriarchate, during a memorial service for Abu Akleh held yesterday at the Roman Catholic Church in Bethlehem.

Israel Arrests Shireen Abu Akleh Pallbearer, <u>THE JORDAN TIMES</u>, May 20, 2022.

Israel has arrested one of the pallbearers of slain Al Jazeera reporter Shireen Abu Akleh, occupation authorities said on Thursday but rejected his lawyer's claim that the detention was linked to his role at the funeral.

The family of Palestinian activist Nizar Banat, beaten to death during his detention by Palestinian security forces, announced in Ramallah on Wednesday they are no longer pursuing a case through the Palestinian judiciary and instead of turning to international courts for justice.

Israeli Military ID's Gun That May Have Killed Journalist, AP, May 19, 2022.

The Israeli military has identified a soldier's rifle that may have killed Al Jazeera journalist Shireen Abu Akleh, but said it cannot be certain unless the Palestinians turn over the bullet for analysis, a military official said Thursday.

Israeli occupation forces today attacked scores of Palestinian workers near the Israeli segregation barrier outside the villages of Anin, Rummana, and Zububa, to the west of Jenin in the north of the West Bank, as the latter were heading to their workplaces inside Israel, according to Palestinian security sources.

Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu will depart for Palestine and Israel on May 24 and will hold talks on the normalization of bilateral ties with the Israeli government in a first senior-level visit in 15 years.

Muslim Charity Supports Palestine Refugees with Insulin Donation, **UNRWA**, MAY 23, 2022.

Muslim charity contributed us\$ 75,000 to enable the United Nations relief and works agency for Palestine refugees in the near east (UNRWA) to provide 630 Palestine refugee patients in Gaza with a two-month supply of insulin for the treatment of type 1 diabetes. an estimated 52,000 Palestine refugees rely on the UNRWA health program for the treatment of diabetes each year.

UNRWA Commissioner-General Meets New Dutch Government on His First Official Visit to The Netherlands, <u>UNRWA</u>, May 22, 2022.

Counting The Cost of Israel's War on Gaza, One Year On (by Sally Ibrahim), The New Arab, May 19, 2022.

The human and economic cost to Gaza was greater than in Israel, as it always is, and Tel Aviv will point to victories for the Iron Dome system, which minimized damage from rocket fire, which

has subsequently decreased since the conflict. In reality, however, it is only a matter of time before the next conflict, as the structural conditions remain the same. Gaza is still under a crippling blockade, settlements are still expanding in East Jerusalem, and violations at the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound could escalate into wider tensions at any moment.

The EU continues to blackmail Palestinians through the weaponisation of anti-Semitism (by Muhammad Hussein), The New Arab, May 19, 2022.

Over the past year, the European Union has delayed the transfer of hundreds of millions of Euros in its annual aid to the Palestinian Authority (PA), solely over the allegations that the PA's school textbooks contain some content deemed "anti-Semitic". The restriction of the annual funding – last year's as well as this year's – came after Oliver Varhelyi, a Hungarian diplomat and the EU's commissioner for neighbourhood and enlargement in Brussels, proposed that the aid to the PA should be conditional on the removal of "problematic content" in the school textbooks.
