#### President Abbas welcomes President Biden's visit to Palestine, <u>WAFA</u> News Agency, June 22, 2022.

President Mahmoud Abbas, the President of the State of Palestine, welcomed the announced visit by U.S. President Joe Biden to Palestine which has been scheduled for July.

#### Israel to Dissolve Government to Preserve Apartheid, <u>THE ELECTRONIC</u> INTIFADA, June 22, 2022.

Israel is set to dissolve its government to maintain its apartheid system in the West Bank, where Palestinians have lived under military dictatorship since it was occupied in 1967.

TEL AVIV, Israel (AP) — Israeli forces shot and killed a Palestinian man on Sunday, the Palestinian Health Ministry said, after the Israeli military said he tried to illegally cross the separation barrier that divides Israel and the occupied West Bank.

A Palestinian was fatally shot by the IDF while trying to sabotage a separation fence by Kalkilya in the West Bank on Sunday morning, according to a report by Ynet.

Dozens of Palestinians participated today in a sit-in in Ramallah in support of two Palestinian prisoners, who have been on an open-ended hunger strike in protest of their administrative detention in Israel.

Israeli warplanes attacked several locations in the besieged Gaza Strip on Saturday morning, causing heavy damage but no injuries, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

Ten others were injured in the latest deadly Israeli raid in the occupied West Bank.

Israeli authorities increased by 2,000 the number of works permits for Gaza Palestinians, to a total of 14,000, and intend to add 20,000 work permits for West Bank Palestinians.

# World Refugee Day: Arab League Stresses Right of Return for Palestinians, **Doha News**, June 20, 2022.

The Arab League has shone a light on the right of return for Palestinian refugees that have been forced to leave their homes since the establishment of Israel in 1948. In a statement to mark UN World Refugees Day on Monday, the bloc also said compensation and restoration of property

should be looked into, emphasising the importance of ensuring the protection of displaced Palestinians as well as the refugees and immigrants.

# Lebanese Maronite Patriarch Calls For 'Final Solution' For Palestinian Refugees, THE JERUSALEM POST, June 20, 2022.

The patriarch stressed that "everyone" has disavowed the Palestinian demand for a "right of return." Lebanon's Maronite Patriarch Bechara Boutros al-Rahi called on Saturday for the deportation and resettlement of Palestinian refugees with the help of the international community, stressing that Lebanon must consider its own national interests.

#### EU, Egypt Stress Two-State Solution only Path to Resolve Palestine Question, Saudi Gazette, June 20, 2022.

The European Union (EU) and Egypt Monday underlined comprehensive resolution to the Palestine question is the two-state solution that ends Israel occupation and leads to the establishment of an independent, contiguous, sovereign and viable Palestinian State, on the lines of June 4, 1967, with East Jerusalem as its capital.

#### Exeter College JCR Passes Unprecedented Motion Supporting Palestine, WAFA News Agency, June 19, 2022.

The Junior Common Room (JCR), a representative student body within the University of Oxford, has passed an unprecedented motion condemning recent actions by Israel and resolving to donate funds in support of medical aid for Palestinians, the University of Oxford's biggest student newspaper, the Oxford Student.

#### UN Experts Condemn Israel's Arbitrary Detention of Palestinian Aid Worker, WAFA News Agency, June 16, 2022.

UN human rights experts today denounced Israel for abusing counter-terrorism laws to target and silence human rights defenders, after an Israeli court accused Palestinian aid worker Mohammed el-Halabi of "financing terrorism". Francesca Albanese, Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Palestine, and Fionnuala Ni Aolain, Special Rapporteur on the promotion and protection of human rights, said, "The conviction of the former program director of World Vision's Gaza office was a clear violation of Israel's obligation to respect the right to a fair trial and due process, as well as its obligation as an Occupying Power under international humanitarian law."

# During A Visit to Syria, Unrwa Advisory Commission Members Express Their Strong Support to Palestine Refugees, UNRWA, June 20, 2022.

A delegation of UNRWA Advisory Commission members visited UNRWA in Syria on the 18 and 19 June 2022, the first such visit since the conflict started in the country over a decade ago. The delegation included Finland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Lebanon, Norway, Palestine, Sweden, Switzerland, Syria, and the European Union was accompanied by Ms. Leni Stenseth, UNRWA Deputy Commissioner-General, and Mr. Amanya Michael-Ebye, Director of UNRWA Affairs in Syria.

#### UNRWA Inaugurates New School in Saida, Lebanon, <u>UNRWA</u>, June 17, 2022.

Commissioner-General of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA), Philip Lazzarini, said yesterday that "there are no plans to delegate UNRWA's tasks to other parties, but the agency is facing a crisis in obtaining its needs." Speaking at a joint press conference with the head of the Lebanese-Palestinian Dialogue Committee, Lazzarini noted that "UNRWA is trying as much as possible to maintain the basic services it provides to Palestinian refugees", adding that more than 80 percent of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon live below the poverty line.

# UNRWA Chief: No One Will Take Over Agency's Tasks, MIDDLE EAST MONITOR, June 16, 2022.

The United States and France are among the largest donors to UNRWA. In 2021, the United States government contributed US\$ 338.4 million to UNRWA and the French government donated EUR 23.55 million.
