## Israel Shuts Offices of Palestinian Rights Organizations it Labeled Terror Groups, THE TIMES OF ISRAEL, August 18, 2022.

IDF troops confiscate property, weld doors of offices in Ramallah shut, after defense minister ratifies the 2021 decision to outlaw groups over alleged ties to PFLP.

#### Israeli Forces Raid Offices of Several Palestinian CSOs in Ramallah, <u>WAFA</u> News Agency, August 18, 2022.

Israeli forces Thursday dawn raided the headquarters of seven Palestinian human rights and civil society organizations in the occupied West Bank cities of Ramallah and al-Bireh and ordered the places to be shut down, according to local sources.

# Israeli Occupation Court Rejects Appeal for Release of Hunger-Striking Prisoner Khalil Awawdeh, WAFA News Agency, August 15, 2022.

Israeli occupation court rejected today the appeal submitted for the release of prisoner Khalil Awawdeh, who has been on an open-ended hunger strike for 156 consecutive days in protest of his detention without charge or trial, according to his lawyer.

## Israeli Forces Crack Down on Anti-Colonialism Rally in Northern West Bank, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, August 15, 2022.

Israeli forces today cracked down on an anti-colonialism rally close to Beit Lid town, southeast of Tulkarm city in the north of the West Bank, according to WAFA correspondent.

# Israeli Army Killing of Palestinian Youth Is a Crime That Deserves International Investigation, Says Official, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, August 15, 2022.

The Secretary General of the Executive Committee of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) Hussein al-Sheikh today demanded an urgent international investigation into the Israeli killing of a Palestinian youth near Jerusalem earlier today.

in reaction to the Israeli army killing this morning of 21-year-old Mohammad Shaham in an East Jerusalem neighborhood.

# NRC Calls for International Investigation into Israeli Killing of Three Children Supported by Its Trauma Care Program, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, August 12, 2022.

As Hamas doesn't consider itself responsible for everything that happens in the Strip, Islamic Jihad and the smaller factions there believe they can act against Israel. 'The question is what you want to do, be smart or be right,' security official says.

The Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) has confirmed that three children, aged 15 and 16, supported by the organization's education and psychosocial support program were among those killed in an Israeli airstrike on al-Falluja cemetery, west of Jabalia refugee camp in the northern Gaza Strip on Sunday, calling for an international investigation into their killing.

# Four Palestinian Detainees in Israel Are on Hunger Strike, Including One For 158 Days and A 64-Year-Old Man, WAFA News Agency, August 17, 2022.

Four Palestinian detainees in Israel are currently on hunger strike in protest against their prolonged detention without charge or trial, including one who has been on hunger strike for 158 days, two siblings, and a 64-year-old man from a town inside Israel, today said the Palestinian Prisoner Society (PPS).

# Israeli Court Extends Isolation of a Mentally III Palestinian Prisoner for Six More Months Despite Health Condition, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, August 16, 2022.

An Israeli court in Beer Sheba today extended the isolation of the Palestinian prisoner Ahmad Manasra, 20, despite his critical mental condition, according to attorney Khaled Zabarga.

### Israeli Army Kills Palestinian Youth in Occupied East Jerusalem, ALJAZERA, August 15, 2022.

Israeli forces have killed a Palestinian youth during a military raid on the Kufr Aqab neighborhood of occupied East Jerusalem.

### Palestinian Families Campaigning for Israel to Return Their Children's Bodies, MIDDLE EAST MONITOR, August 14, 2022.

Around 20 years ago, Mohammad Nassar, 62, lost his son, Shadi, who was participating in resistance activities against the Israeli occupation during the second Palestinian intifada, Anadolu Agency reports.

### Israeli Forces Close Western Entrance to Husan Village in Bethlehem, WAFA News Agency, August 14, 2022.

Israeli forces today evening closed the western entrance to the village of Husan, west of Bethlehem, in the southern occupied West Bank, according to a security source.

#### Israel Orders a Halt on Construction of Four Homes Near Ramallah, <u>WAFA</u> News Agency, August 14, 2022.

Israeli occupation authorities ordered today a halt on the construction of four homes in the village of Budrus in the occupied West Bank province of Ramallah, according to local sources.

Israeli police arrest suspected gunman after a shooting attack on a bus in Jerusalem's Old City wounded at least eight people.

# European Union and Member States' Representatives Visit Gaza, Confirm €97m Contribution to UNRWA for 2022, WAFA News Agency, August 16, 2022.

In the aftermath of the latest escalation of violence in the Gaza Strip, the European Union (EU) Representative to West Bank and Gaza, Sven Kühn von Burgsdorff, and other EU Member States' representatives visited today Beach Preparatory School in Beach Palestine refugee camp, run by the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA), according to a press release.

# European Union and Member States Representatives Visit Gaza. Eu Confirms EUR 97 million Contribution to UNRWA For 2022, <u>UNRWA</u>, August 16, 2022.

In the aftermath of the latest escalation of violence in the Gaza Strip, the European Union (EU) Representative to West Bank and Gaza, Mr. Sven Kühn von Burgsdorff, and other EU Member States' representatives visited today UNRWA Beach Preparatory School in Beach Palestine refugee camp. This visit coincided with the signing of the annual EU contribution to UNRWA Programme Budget for 2022, confirming EU and Member States' steadfast commitment to the rights and human development of Palestine refugees living in Gaza, the West Bank, including East Jerusalem, Jordan, Lebanon and Syria, until a just and lasting solution to their plight.

#### UNRWA Response to Renewed Gaza Escalation, UNRWA, August 11, 2022.

Palestine refugees, like all residents in Gaza, once again suffered the consequences of another round of escalation, the worst since May 2021. The United Nations Office of the High Commissioner on Human Rights (OHCHR) has confirmed that 46 Palestinians were killed, including 17 children. Further, the Ministry of Health in Gaza reports that more than 360 others were injured, including 151 children and 58 women. In addition to the devasting loss of life, OCHA reports that some 1,761 housing units sustained damages, with some 8,500 people being impacted by the damages. Some 450 Palestinians were internally displaced, some of whom took shelter in UNRWA schools.
