President Mahmoud Abbas held talks yesterday in New York, where he arrived to attend the United Nations General Assembly meetings, with the Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sánchez, UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres, the head of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) Peter Maurer, and Ronald Lauder, president of the World Jewish Congress.

# Palestinian Parents, Students Protest 'Israelization' Of Curriculum, <u>Arab News</u>, September 19, 2022.

Palestinian parents and students succeeded in closing most schools in East Jerusalem on Monday in protest at attempts by the Israeli Ministry of Education to force them to accept a censored version of the Palestinian curriculum.

# Israel Revised its West Bank Travel Restrictions in Hopes of Obtaining a US Visa Waiver, But They Still Discriminate Against Palestinians, Mondoweiss, September 19, 2022.

"Allowing Israel into the U.S. Visa Waiver program in spite of this mistreatment would amount to an endorsement by the Biden administration of this discrimination," says Americans for Justice in Palestine Action Advocacy Director Ayah Ziyadeh.

#### Palestinian Schools in Jerusalem to Go on Strike against Israel's Attempts to Impose Textbooks, THE PALESTINE CHRONICLE, September 18, 2022.

The Palestinian schools in occupied East Jerusalem are scheduled to go on a one-day strike on Monday, in protest of the Israeli occupation's attempts to impose its textbooks, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

# Palestinian Parents Protest Israeli Attempts to Impose 'Distorted' Textbooks in East Jerusalem Schools, <u>THE ARAB NEWS</u>, September 18, 2022.

Palestinian parents say that Israeli authorities are attempting to 'distort' facts about Palestinian identity and history in amended textbooks across a number of Palestinian schools in east Jerusalem, including Al-Iman.

Dozens of members of the European Parliament (MEPs) have nominated slain Palestinian journalist Shireen Abu Akleh for the Sakharov Prize for Freedom of Thought, the EU's highest honor for human rights defenders.

President Mahmoud Abbas met this evening with his Irish counterpart Michael Higgins shortly upon his arrival at Dublin International Airport.

### Israel's Denial of Accountability for Abu Akleh Killing May Require Cutoff of Aid — Leahy, Mondoweiss, September 16, 2022.

Sen. Patrick Leahy said that Shireen Abu Akleh's killing on May 11 was intentional, and if Israel does not hold anyone accountable, "then the Leahy Law must be applied."

#### Remembering the Sabra and Shatila Massacre 40 Years On, <u>WAFA News</u> Agency, September 15, 2022.

On these days 40 years ago, several thousand Palestinian refugees and Lebanese civilians were being brutally massacred by a pro-Israel militia group immediately after the Israeli army under Ariel Sharon had occupied the Lebanese capital, Beirut, where the Sabra and Shatila refugee camps are located.

### Suffocation injuries during Israeli assault on schools near Nablus, Ramallah, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, September 21, 2022.

A number of Palestinian students Wednesday suffered from suffocation after Israeli forces fired tear gas bombs at a school in the village of Burqa, northwest of the occupied West Bank city of Nablus, local sources said.

A rare operation by the Palestinian Authority security forces to arrest a Hamas member sparked clashes in the West Bank city of Nablus on Tuesday, multiple sources said.

### Israeli Occupation Forces Detain 23 Palestinians Mainly in Hebron and Jerusalem Districts, WAFA News Agency, September 19, 2022.

The Israeli occupation forces detained today and last night at least 23 Palestinians in the occupied territories but mainly from the Hebron and Jerusalem districts, according to the Palestinian Prisoner Society (PPS).

Israeli Forces Raid Home of Al-Aqsa Mosque Director, Detain Him, <u>THE</u> <u>PALESTINE CHRONICLE</u>, September 19, 2022.

Israeli forces broke into the home of the director of Al-Aqsa Mosque, Sheikh Omar Kiswani, in occupied East Jerusalem on Monday and detained him, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

### Palestinian Parents, Students in Jerusalem Protest Israel's Attempts to Impose Deformed Textbooks, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, September 17, 2022.

Palestinian parents and students in occupied East Jerusalem today held protests in several neighborhoods against attempts by the Israeli occupation authorities to prevent the school from teaching the official Palestinian textbooks and rather use the distorted Israeli-issued textbooks.
