On Wednesday, March 9, 2022 - Member of the PLO's Executive Committee and Fatah's Central Committee and head of the General Authority of Civil Affairs in the Palestinian Authority, Hussein al-Sheikh, reconfirmed during a meeting t with Israeli Foreign Minister, Yair Lapid, the necessity of having a political horizon based on signed agreements and the resolutions of international legitimacy.

On Monday, March 7, 2022 – Adalah – The Legal Center for Arab Minority Rights in Israel, in coordination with the Civic Coalition for Defending Palestinians' Rights in Jerusalem, filed a petition to the Israeli Supreme Court on behalf of seven residents of Sheikh Jarrah and the Welfare Association of Sheikh Jarrah, demanding the immediate dismantlement of 10 police checkpoints placed both around and within the western part of Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood of occupied East Jerusalem.

In A Bid to Grab Palestinian Land, Israeli Colonialists Set Up the Tent, Mobile Homes on Land in A West Bank Town, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, March 7, 2022.

On Monday, March 7, 2022 – In a bid to steal Palestinian land, Israeli colonial settlers set up a large tent and a mobile home in the southern West Bank town of Battir, west of Bethlehem city, said a local activist.

More than 10,000 Palestinians were issued travel bans by Israel in 2021, and many of them only find out at the border.

Defense ministry brings in new regulations concerning international students and their teachers.

Israel Razes Homes of Two Palestinian Assailants Over Deadly West Bank Shooting, *HAARETZ*, March 8, 2022.

The men are accused of shooting at a car driving near a West Bank outpost, killing a Jewish seminary student and wounding two others.

Israeli Forces Re-arrest French-Palestinian Human Rights Lawyer Salah Hamouri, <u>THE PALESTINE CHRONICLE</u>, March 7, 2022.

Israeli forces detained French-Palestinian lawyer and human rights activist Salah Hamouri, after breaking into his house in Kufr Aqab, north of Jerusalem, early Monday morning, according to prisoners' rights group Addameer.

International Community's Double Standards Have Become a Cover for Israel's Violations and Crimes – Foreign Ministry, <u>WAFA News</u> Agency, March 7, 2022.

The incident took place at Bab Hutta, one of the gates to the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound.

Palestinian Activist from Jerusalem Threatened with Israeli Expulsion, WAFA News Agency, March 3, 2022.

On Thursday, March 03, 2022 – Awad Salaymeh, a Palestinian rights activist from occupied Jerusalem, said he was threatened with expulsion from his home city by the Israeli occupation authorities in the event he continued advocating for the issue of the Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood.

Israel has made it no secret that it would like to see Saudi Arabia join the historic Abraham Accords, as Bahrain and the United Arab Emirates did, but the Saudis have said the issue was not on the agenda at this time.

Jordan Valley Land Declared a Nature Reserve A Few Years Ago Is Going to Be Turned into A Settlement, WAFA News Agency, March 3, 2022.

On Thursday, March 3, 2022 — an area in the occupied Jordan Valley that the Israeli authorities have turned into a nature reserve a few years ago is in the process of becoming a new settlement, said a local Palestinian official.

International

U.S. House Approves \$1b Iron Dome Emergency Aid to Israel in Omnibus Spending Package, (by Ben Samuels), *HAARETZ*, March 10, 2022.

On Wednesday, March 9, 2022— Under the auspices and in the presence of Prime Minister Mohammed Shtayyeh, Belgian Consul General Wilfried Pfeffer in Jerusalem signed on behalf of the Government of Belgium a cooperation program worth 70 million Euros for the years 2022-2026.

Rights Groups Urge Europeans to Adopt a Consistent Approach Toward Human Rights for the Palestinian People, <u>WAFA News Agency</u>, March 8, 2022.

On Wednesday, March 9, 2022 - The Cairo Institute for Human Rights Studies (CIHRS) and partners in Europe and Palestine, including Al-Haq, wrote to key European Union (EU) institutions and Member States and the United Kingdom (UK) urging them to uphold the rule of international law and human rights for the Palestinian people at the current UN Human Rights Council session.

"An Employed Woman Has To Bear Additional Burdens": First UNRWA Teacher Wins The Gold Medal For Global Creative Women Award, UNRWA, March 7, 2022.

Asmaa Muammar, a Palestine refugee teacher at Fukhari Elementary Girls school in Gaza, won the Gold Medal for the Global Creative Women Award (GCWA) 2021, after passing four tests with distinction. The GCWA is an initiative of Global Trainer Academy to encourage skilled women to present their talent.

Consul General of Spain Meets with UNRWA Commissioner-General in Jerusalem, <u>UNRWA</u>, March 4, 2022.

On March 04, 2022 - the Spanish Consul-General, Mr. Alfonso Lucini Mateo, and the Head of Cooperation of the Consulate General of Spain in Jerusalem, Ms. Eva Suárez Leonardo, met with the Commissioner-General of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), Mr. Philippe Lazzarini.

UNRWA And Eu Help Palestine Refugees in Syria with Emergency Cash Assistance, <u>UNRWA</u>, March 4, 2022.

In 2021, the European Union (EU) contributed EUR 2 million to the 2021 Syria Regional Conflict Emergency Appeal of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East for humanitarian assistance to conflict-affected Palestine refugees. This funding contributed to the Agency's efforts to provide 28,622 vulnerable Palestine refugees with emergency cash assistance to help them meet their most basic needs such as food, shelter or heating. Over a period of five months, Palestine refugees were provided US\$ 14, equivalent to EUR 11.86, (SYP 35,000) every month.
