In October 2018, Arab Renaissance for Democracy and Development (ARDD), witnessed the inauguration of a major three-year programmatic initiative on “The Question of Palestine 70 Years On: Priorities for Action” aiming to inject new innovative thinking into the discourse around the unresolved Israeli-Palestinian conflict. Through ARDD’s established Global Network of Experts on the Question of Palestine meetings and stakeholder consultations and coordination, the initiative will create an indispensable platform to influence for key decision-makers and partners actors on Palestine more broadly.

The last three months witnessed further violations in Palestine as Israel started to demolish more than 100 Palestinians homes in Jerusalem's outskirts, attacked worshipers performing Eid prayers at Al Aqsa, Palestinian refugees face sanctions for working illegally in Lebanon and protest for more rights, in addition to the ever-increasing threats facing UNRWA in the face of alleged rumors.

ARDD's quarterly newsletter on the Question of Palestine in its 3rd edition and through its selected articles, reports and testimonials showcases information and news from our experts and institutions and reporters tackling Palestinian issues and aims to raise awareness about the conflict's background in order to conduct a meaningful dialogue about Palestinian identity and future policy.

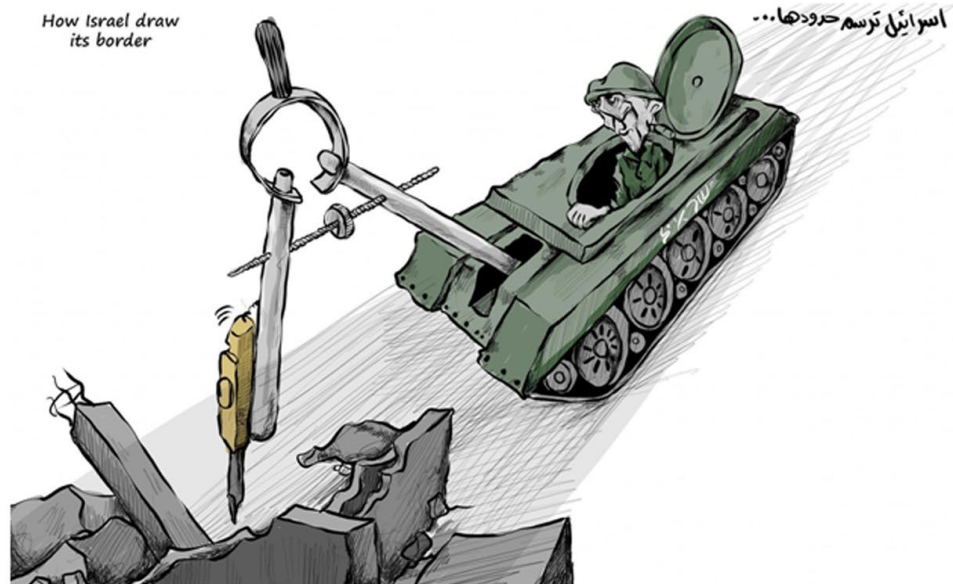
